

## **O.P.P. Won't Reopen Project Truth Investigation**

**December 16, 2009** — The O.P.P. is not about to delve back into its Project Truth investigation into claims of a pedophile clan in Cornwall. The commissioner of the Cornwall Public Inquiry slammed the police force yesterday for its botched case saying it failed to investigate possible links between victims and perpetrators. O.P.P. Inspector Dave Ross tells AM 1220 News the inquiry recommendations are being reviewed but not the case in 1997. (Hear audio clip below) He says there would have to be new and compelling evidence to reopen a case. Ross says many of the commissioner's recommendations have already been addressed, including a special model for large-scale investigations.

“At this time there’s no grounds to reopen the investigation. The purpose of the inquiry was to make recommendations for police services and other justice sector agencies, to better serve the public in the future as opposed to going back in time”
