(PUBLIC INQUIRIES ACT, S-S.5(2))

This notice is given without prejudice to the ability of the Cornwall Public Inquiry, through its counsel, to modify the particulars of the substance of the alleged misconduct as circumstances may necessitate.

As provided by subsection 5(2) of the *Public Inquiries Act*, receipt of this notice entitles you full opportunity to be heard in person or through counsel with regard to those issues or areas of evidence that affect your interest.

SCHEDULE A

SUBSTANCE OF ALLEGED MISCONDUCT

In his report(s), the Commissioner may find that, while a member of the Cornwall Community Police Services (CPS):

1. You conducted investigations into allegations of criminal conduct without the knowledge, authorization and/or involvement of the CPS, including taking statements from, among others, C-8, Carol Deschamps, David Silmser, Doug MacDonald, Ron Leroux, Dale Crowder, Gerald Renshaw, Cara Lee Berry, and Fred Renshaw.
2. Without the knowledge, authorization and/or involvement of the CPS, you communicated with complainants and witnesses in on-going criminal investigations, including, among others, C-8 and Barbara MacCrimmon.
3. You breached CPS policies, procedures and orders regarding communications with complainants and witnesses, including failing to keep of proper notes and records of the communications.
4. Upon receipt of allegations of criminal conduct and/or information relevant to on-going criminal investigations, you failed to report or otherwise bring the allegations and/or information to the attention of the CPS, in a timely manner or at all.
5. You breached CPS policies, procedures and orders regarding the disclosure of notes and records of your communications with complainants and witnesses including the written order contained in the letter to you from Inspector Richard Trew dated September 25, 1997 and you failed to disclose notes and records of your communications with complainants and witnesses to the CPS, in a timely manner or at all.
6. You provided false and/or misleading information regarding the existence of notes and records of your communications with complainants and witnesses and regarding the disclosure of same.
7. You breached CPS policies, procedures and orders regarding media contact including the written order contained in the interoffice memorandum to you from Inspector Richard Trew dated August 7, 1997.
8. You breached CPS policies, procedures and orders and your oath of secrecy by providing information and statements from complainants and witnesses to third parties.
