
and we attempted to deliver one box to the:

At Mr. Flaherty's office, we were directed to take the box of documents to the 10 Th. floor, where we were eventually received by Crown Attorney, Shelly Hallett. In our conversation of about one hour and fifteen minutes, Ms. Hallett did not want to receive the documents, explaining that (even though Perry Dunlop was a policeman and she was a Crown Attorney) the procedure was that police give information to Crown Attorney's. She explained that she already had a copy of the entire information that we were trying to present to her and did not need a duplicate, and that receiving this box somehow made her "a witness."

When Ms. Hallett checked the first document she had and compared it to the original brought to her by Constable Dunlop and found that pages were missing from what the police had passed on to her. Ms Hallet changed her mind and decided to accept the box of documentation from Constable Dunlop and gave him a receipt for same.
