-  Bishop Durocher came from Sudbury. Justice Glaude lives in Sudbury.
-  He worked with the Ontario Police Commission.
-  Evasive when asked if he is or ever was a member of the Knights of Columbus.
-  Says he'll answer the questions he won't answer now when the inquiry starts, and *then* he'll decide if his Cornwall connections are a problem.
-  He hasn't decided if his connections are a problem, but he's spending your hard-earned tax dollars as if they aren't.

That's a lot of red flags!
