

Man on probation in sex case

Carl V. Stone, 65, of Elizaville, Columbia County, was placed on probation for five years Wednesday for sexual attacks on two teen-age brothers in the town of Colonie.

Albany County Judge John J. Clyne also ordered that Stone undergo outpatient psychiatric treatment.

Stone had pleaded guilty to two of four third-degree sodomy charges, accusing him of deviate sexual relations with the two youths on two occasions last June and July at a location off Crescent Road.

In other cases in Albany County Court Wednesday:

Jesus Vidot, 31, of 402 Clinton Ave., Albany, pleaded guilty before Judge Joseph Harris to attempted criminal sale of a controlled substance,

third degree. He had been charged with selling heroin on Nov. 13. Vidot was remanded to Albany County Jail to await sentencing on Jan. 21.

Two men appeared before Harris to plead guilty to promoting gambling, first degree. Samuel J. Germano, 66, of 17 Fullerton St., Albany, and Dominic J. Mufale, 65, of 122 Osborne Road, Colonie, admitted operating an illegal policy game on Fullerton Street on Sept. 17. The two will be sentenced on Jan. 20.

Michael Chamberlain, 24, of Albany, pleaded guilty before Harris to criminal possession of a forged instrument, a stolen U.S. Treasury check in the amount of \$374. He was jailed pending sentencing on Jan. 21.
